Calvert Marine Museum Volunteer Council Scholarship Program 2020

Background: The Volunteer Council (VC) of the Calvert Marine Museum (CMM) recruits and promotes the effective use of volunteer services through organization, training, and communication in order to contribute to the mission and purposes of the museum.

Purpose: To provide financial support to current or enrolled student volunteers. Three or more scholarships in the amount of \$750 each will be available (as funding or suitable applicants permit). Funds are intended to offset education-related costs. The scholarship is open to applicants pursuing education in any field, but preferably those that support the activities of the museum, such as, maritime history, estuarine biology, paleontology, development, marketing, etc. This scholarship may not be combined with any other scholarship funding administered by the museum or its clubs. This does not preclude prior year recipients from applying.

Scholarships may be used at the post-secondary school level, including training and vocational programs, of the student's choice. Each scholarship will be paid directly to the student after they have shown evidence of acceptance and enrollment.

Eligibility: High school graduate or graduating senior from any educational institution (public or private high school, home school, or GED certificate).

Selection Criteria:

- Academic achievement must be at least a high school graduate or graduating senior
- Academic plans Although not required, preference will be given to students who are applying to a course of study that supports any activity related to the museum. Scholarship award will be contingent upon acceptance and enrollment
- Applicant must have completed at least 20 hours of volunteer service to CMM during the period January through December 2019
- Preference will be given to volunteers who have shown a continuing interest or commitment to volunteer during the forthcoming year
- Volunteer must be 25 years or under as of March 31, 2020
- Interview If there are questions, the committee may contact the applicant for a telephone interview.

Important Dates and Mandatory Deadlines:

- Scholarship applications must be <u>received</u> at the Calvert Marine Museum no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday March 31, 2020.
- Scholarship phone interviews, if deemed desirable, will be conducted between April 10-30, 2020.
- Each applicant will be notified of the decision by May 11, 2020.

Documents: To be considered, your application packet must include:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. A personal narrative statement (typed) which should include a description of:
 - Why you volunteer at the museum and how it benefits you

- The area(s) (e.g., estuarine, education, etc.) or museum events in which you volunteer
- How your course of study will benefit the museum.
- 3. A written reference from a museum staff member, preferably one that you support or report to. Contact a staff member and ask them if they would submit a Recommendation sheet on you. If so, give them the Recommendation sheet and ask them to return it directly to the Volunteer Coordinator.
- 4. Proof of acceptance or enrollment.

Applications will be reviewed, and scholarships awarded, by the VC selection committee.
